Method of Bidding will be as follows:

- A. **UNIT PRICE BID FOR PEMBROKE AVENUE FORCE MAIN** consists of construction of approximately 5,070 linear feet of 20- inch PVC AND HDPE sewage force main installed conventional open-trench installation methods, 360 linear feet of 20-inch HDPE pipe installed by horizontal directional drilling, 100 linear feet of 36-inch steel casing installed by boring and jacking under railroad rights-of-way; combination air release assemblies, tie-into the South Avenue Lift Station and existing 20-inch force main, and other appurtenances necessary to complete the Sewage Force Main Replacement as described in the Specifications and on the CONSTRUCTION DRAWINGS.

The Cost Estimate for this Contract is \$ 1,300,000 . 00

Bidding documents may be obtained from the Muskingum County Project Department, 401 Main Street, First Floor, Zanesville, Ohio, 43701 between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and Noon and 1:00 p.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding holidays.

A non-refundable deposit shall be required for the bidding documents in the amount of \$100.00 for each contract with checks payable to the Muskingum County Treasurer. This deposit is required before the documents can be made available.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any informalities in the bids received, and to accept any bid which is deemed most favorable to the OWNER at the time and under the conditions stipulated. Owner further declare that they will award the contracts for this project to the lowest and best bid, which may not necessarily be the lowest bid.

Each Bidder must submit with his bid, security in the amount, form and subject to the conditions provided in the Information for Bidders.

Each Proposal must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the proposal and all persons interested therein. If requested, each bidder must submit evidence of its experiences on projects of similar size and complexity.

All contractors and subcontractors involved with the project will, to the extent practicable use Ohio Products, materials, services, and labor in the implementation of their project. Additionally, contractor compliance with the equal employment opportunity requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123, the Governor's Executive Order of 1972, and Governor's Executive Order 84-9 shall be required.

All work done under these two contracts shall be subject to all Ohio State requirements concerning the payment of applicable prevailing wage rates.

No Bidder may withdraw his bid within 60 days after the actual date of the opening thereof.
