

CERTIFICATION OF TRAINING FOR LIVE BURNS

certify that _____ is a member of the fire department and is attending this live burn training as a part of our departments training program.

He has a current firefighter certification to the _____ Level.

If the firefighter is certified as a volunteer firefighter he has been provided with additional training to permit him to function safely at the live burn. The minimum additional training he has received is:

- 1 Hour of training on fire behavior in structures
- 2 Hours of building construction for one and two family dwellings and light weight construction.
- 2 Hours of practical fire hose, streams and appliances training in safely advancing charged hose lines into structures, up and down stairs. He has performed the evolutions as a nozzle and back up person on both two and three person hoselines. This was accomplished in full PPE with out facepiece to learn proper techniques and in obscured vision demonstrating his ability to work safely in heavy smoke.
- 1 Hour of practical fire stream evolutions demonstrating proper procedure to attack interior structure fires. Fire scenarios included fully involved structures, room and contents, and concealed space fires. Additional training included the proper use of fire streams for firefighter protection, flashover prevention, and ventilation. This was accomplished in full PPE with out facepiece to learn proper techniques and in obscured vision demonstrating his ability to work safely in heavy smoke.
- 2 Hours of practical ground ladder evolutions utilizing 2 and 3 person carries and raises of fire department ladders. Evolutions will include climbing, entering exiting windows, tool carries, advancing lines over ladders, and emergency exits from buildings using ladders. This was accomplished in full PPE to learn proper techniques of safe ladder work on the fire ground.
- 1 Hour of practical ventilation training of residential dwellings to include vertical, horizontal, positive pressure and negative pressure ventilation. This was accomplished in full PPE to learn proper techniques of safe ladder work on the fire ground.
